Simply go to [Triage Cancer's website](#) to start the process. You will be asked five basic questions about your situation and the website will generate a list with your possible health insurance options and assistance programs.

This is also a great tool for health care professionals to use to help patients, as only limited demographic information is needed (e.g., zip code, age, and income level).

The results are presented in an easy to read chart that is printable for future reference.
