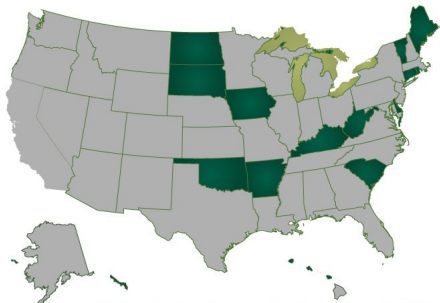

## In 2016, Triage Cancer:



- Reached more than 5,568 people through 98 seminars, webinars, conferences, and tweet chats in 20 states.
- Hosted a Speakers Bureau of 55 experts in cancer survivorship & survivors

Between 2012 and 2016, Triage Cancer participated in 509 in-person educational events in 38 states, addressing more than 127,000 cancer survivors, caregivers, advocates, elected officials, employers, and health care professionals. Additionally, hundreds of thousands of people have been reached through the website, educational blog, and e-newsletters. 99% of every dollar raised, funds programs.
