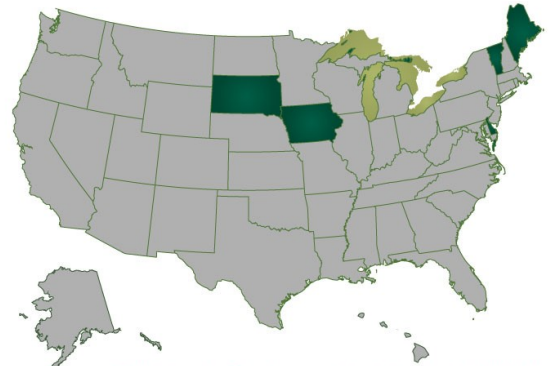


ABOUT TRIAGE CANCER
