Volunteers will:

- ▶ Be willing to accept, and respond to, emails from Triage Cancer attorneys who have identified the volunteer as a possible referral for a caller (based on the volunteer's subject-matter expertise and location)
- ▶ If a volunteer accepts a referral, after an introductory email from Triage Cancer, they will arrange a virtual meeting with the caller and provide a free, 30-minute consultation. Following that initial meeting, they will provide guidance, advice, and/or representation as agreed to directly with the caller.
