In 2024 alone, we reached more than 1 million people through our websites, educational materials, and blog.

Since 2012, we have educated more than 525,000 people through 1,600+ events across all 50 states, DC, Puerto Rico, Guam, and Canada. Our Legal & Financial Navigation Program provided direct one-on-one support to more than 2,000 individuals in 2024.

Each year, Triage Cancer hosts 30+ signature educational events and participates in 180+ partner events, equipping patients, caregivers, advocates, navigators, community health workers, and health care professionals with knowledge they share in their communities. 


### **Triage Cancer Webinar Series (12)**

Triage Cancer hosts a national Webinar Series addressing the practical and legal issues that arise after a cancer diagnosis. These free, live webinars provide expert guidance on topics such as access to care, health and disability insurance, employment rights, finances, and more, ensuring that patients, caregivers, advocates, and professionals have access to the critical information they need.

5,550 people registered for our webinars in 2024

With 60+ organizational partners actively promoting the series to their audiences, our webinars reach thousands of participants nationwide and remain accessible on-demand at <a href="mailto:TriageCancer.org/Past-Webinars">TriageCancer.org/Past-Webinars</a>.



In 2024, we hosted 11 webinars with a combined 2,671 attendees.

Based on post-event evaluation data, at least 98% of each webinar's attendees "strongly agreed" or "agreed" that they had a better understanding of the topic(s) covered after participating in the webinar they attended.

We are hosting 16 webinars in 2025. Our webinar on recent health policy changes had more than 3,400 registrants alone.
